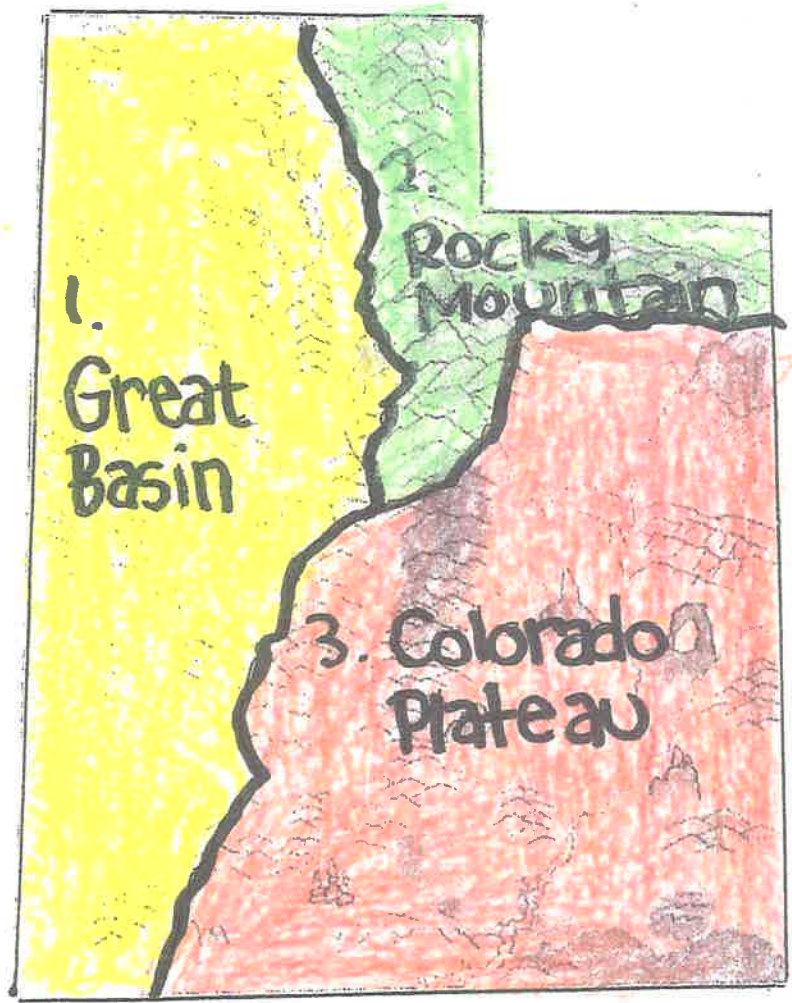

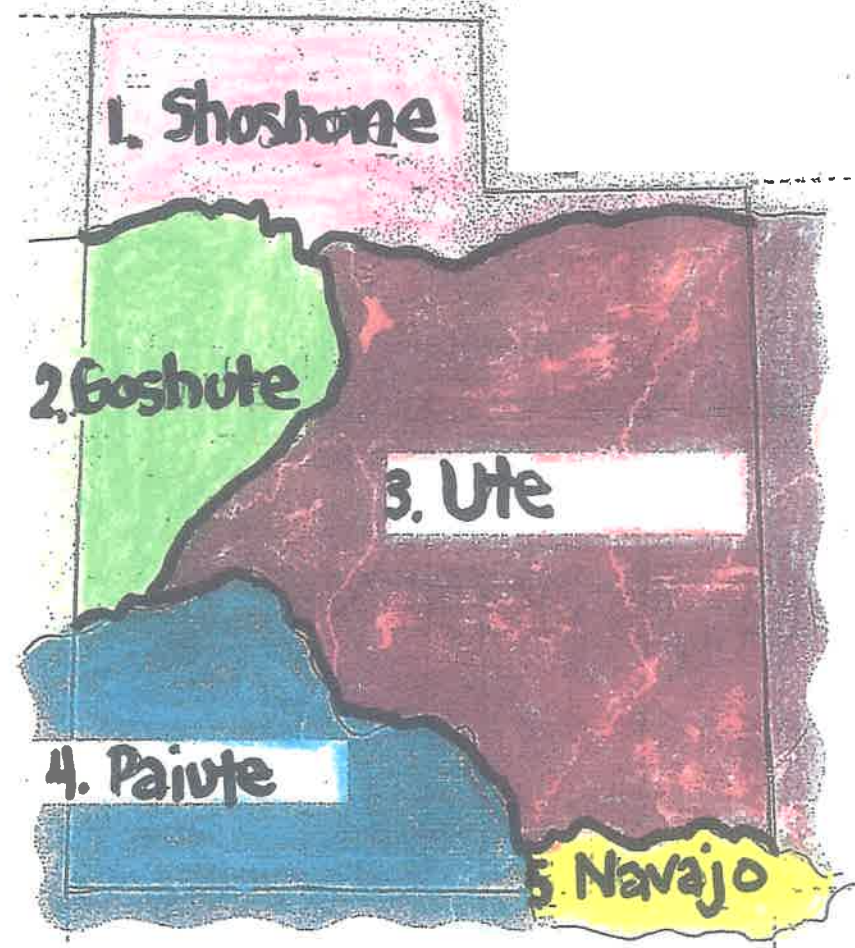


On the Map below:
Label and color the **5 main Tribes of Utah** and original territories. The Tribe names must be spelled correctly.

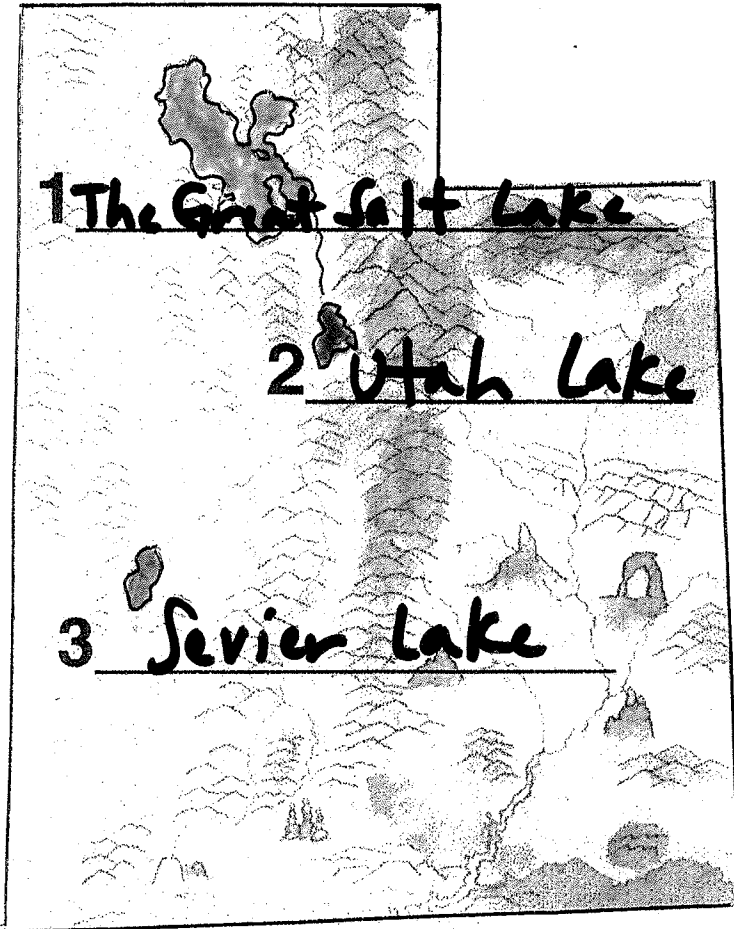


On the Map above:
